Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-31 (c.f. Judges 3:15-23)

God raised up an unlikely, unrighteous, unexpected deliverer in Ehud. How is Christian conversion similar? (1 Cor 1:26-28).

To what extent does your conversion story reflect this pattern?

Why does God often work this way? (1 Cor 1:29-31)
